MAN AND UNIVERSE

Man, know thyself and you'll know the universe!

... "It is not physical phenomena but these universal ideas that we study, as to comprehend the former [phenomena], we have to first understand the later [universal ideas]. They touch **man's true position in the universe**, in relation to his previous and future births; his origin and ultimate destiny; the relation of the mortal to the immortal; of the temporary to the eternal; of the finite to the Infinite; ideas larger, grander, more comprehensive, recognizing the universal reign of Immutable Law, unchanging and unchangeable in regard to which there is only an ETERNAL NOW, while to uninitiated mortals time is past or future as related to their finite existence on this material speck of dirt. This is what we study and what many have solved.
